Clue nº7

Congratulations, you have completed your game circuit. Now, you know what these elements are used for !

ANSWERS

- 7 Porticullis : a gate lowered using a winch to close the access.
- e **annhole**: new form of murder hole to place the artillery (guns).
- 2 qnudeou or keep : a 24 meter high tower which is the best place for observation.
 - 4 preastplate is the part of the armor of the knight which protects his bust.
 - 3 watchtower which provides retuge to the knight to operate the surveillance.
- 2 **qrop-box** through which stones or boiling liquids were dropped onto the enemy below.
 - 1 **drawbridge** rocker that raise by a counterweight system.

The attack is won, you can return your sword and your shield!
